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10 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 11 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 12 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 13 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 14 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 15 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 16 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 17 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 18

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20 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 21 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 22 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 23 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 24 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 25 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 26 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 27 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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29 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 84th 30 General Assembly meeting in Second Extraordinary Session that the Arkansas 31 Supreme Court in Lake View School District No. 25 v. Huckabee, 351 Ark. 31 32 (2002) declared the now extent system of education to be unconstitutional 33 because it is both inequitable and inadequate; and the Arkansas Supreme Court 34 set forth the test for a constitutional system to be one in which the State 35 has an "absolute duty" to provide an "equal opportunity to an adequate education"; and the Arkansas Supreme Court instructed the General Assembly to 36

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1	define and provide what is necessary to provide an adequate and equitable
2	education for the children of Arkansas-forthwith; that a delay in the
3	effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper
4	administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,
5	an emergency is declared to exist and this act being necessary for the
6	immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in
7	full force and effect from and after July 1, 2004.
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
