## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REQUIRE SCHOOL UNIFORMS IN SCHOOL DISTRICTS IN WHICH SEVENTY-FIVE PERCENT (75\%) OR MORE OF THE STUDENTS FALL BELOW PROFICIENCY DURING TWO (2) CONSECUTIVE YEARS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

> AN ACT TO REQUIRE SCHOOL UNIFORMS IN SCHOOL DISTRICTS IN WHICH SEVENTY-FIVE PERCENT (75\%) OR MORE OF THE STUDENTS FALL BELOW PROFICIENCY DURING TWO (2) CONSECUTIVE YEARS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 18, Subchapter 1 is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

6-18-106. School uniforms.
(a) If over the preceding two (2) school years, seventy-five percent (75\%) or more of the students in a school district score below proficiency on the primary benchmark exams or other exams designated by the Department of Education, the district shall require school uniforms for all students in the district.
(b) Upon request from public school administrators, the department and educational cooperatives shall assist public schools by providing information regarding uniform dress codes.
