1	6-21-404.	Duties	of	State	Board	of	Education	generally	

- 2 (a) The State Board of Education is authorized and empowered to:
- 3 (1) Make rules and regulations to implement this subchapter and 4 to provide for a statewide textbook selection committee;
- 5 (2) Require reports from school districts on the use and 6 distribution of these items; and
- 7 (3) Do whatever else may be necessary for the general welfare of 8 the public school textbook and instructional materials system in order to 9 acquire the items at the lowest possible cost.
- 10 (b)(1) Beginning with the 2004-2005 school year, the State Board shall
 11 adopt a uniform list as required under §6-21-405(a) of textbooks to provide
 12 for a single common textbook for use in:
- (A) Each of the academic classes required to be offered to

 students in grades nine through twelve (9-12) under the Arkansas Standards of

 Accreditation in Arkansas Public Schools; and
- 16 <u>(B) Reading, English, and math classes offered to students</u> 17 in grades kindergarten through eight (K-8).
- 18 (2) As uniform textbooks are adopted, the requirement for school
 19 districts to use the textbooks shall be incorporated into Arkansas Standards
 20 of Accreditation in Arkansas Public Schools.

- 24 throughout the school year.
 - (b) School Except as required in subsection (e) of this section with respect to uniform textbooks, school districts may elect to purchase instructional materials from the state-recommended list, or districts may select other instructional materials.
 - (c) If a school district selects other instructional material not recommended by the state, the district shall certify to the department by June of each year which instructional materials the district wishes to purchase by state contract from the state-recommended list.
- 33 (d) If a school district selects other instructional materials not 34 recommended by the state, the district may purchase such materials outside 35 any state contract.
