19	SECTION 1. FUNDING	TRANSFER. Immediately upon the eff	ective date of	
20	this act, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his books			
21	and those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State the sum of			
22	eighty million dollars (\$80,000,000), or so much thereof as	<u>is available,</u>	
23	from funds received from the Jobs and Growth Tax Relief Reconciliation Act of

2	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,

6	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
