19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION -
22 REVENUE DIVISION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance
23 and Administration - Revenue Services Division, to be payable from the
24 Miscellaneous Revolving Fund, for the purpose of paying claims against the

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23 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
24 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. The clerk
25 of the State Claims Commission is hereby made the disbursing officer for the
26 purpose of paying the claims appropriated by this Act. The Clerk of the
27 State Claims Commission is hereby authorized to receive all warrants prepared
28 under the provisions of this Act from the Auditor of the State and to
29 distribute same to the claimants.

31 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
32 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. DEPARTMENT
33 OF HUMAN SERVICES. For any claims in this Act appropriated to the Department
34 of Human Services, the Clerk of the State Claims Commission shall consult
35 with the Department of Human Services and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
36 State to determine the division and funds to which liability should be

1 assigned and from which the warrants shall be drawn. The Clerk of the State
2 Claims Commission shall initiate the appropriate transfers as may be required
3 and as approved by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State.
4

5 *SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS*
6 *CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CLAIMS*
7 *FROM CASH FUNDS. In the event that any claim authorized herein is determined*
8 *to be a valid claim against the State and the claim is to be paid from funds*
9 *not in the State Treasury, the Clerk of the State Claims Commission shall*
10 *notify the agency against which the claim is to be charged of the amount of*
11 *such claims. Upon receipt of such notification, the state agency shall*
12 *forthwith deliver a check to the Clerk of the State Claims Commission who*
13 *shall deposit the same as a non-revenue receipt into the Miscellaneous*
14 *Revolving Fund from which he shall disburse the amount of the claim to the*
15 *claimant.*
16

17 *SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS*
18 *CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EMPLOYMENT*
19 *COMPENSATION CLAIMS. The Clerk of the State Claims Commission shall not*
20 *distribute any warrants prepared under the provisions of this Act for awards*
21 *made by the Arkansas State Claims Commission for employment compensation*
22 *claims. Upon the award by the State Claims Commission of an employment*
23 *compensation claim, the Clerk of the State Claims Commission shall notify the*
24 *affected state agency and the Department of Finance and Administration -*
25 *Office of Personnel Management of such amounts that are due and payable. The*
26 *affected state agency shall then process the award through the State*
27 *mechanized Payroll System.*
28

29 *SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS*
30 *CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CLAIMS*
31 *AWARD REPORTING. It is the intent of the General Assembly that when any state*
32 *agency, board, commission or institution of higher education admits liability*
33 *to a claim filed with the State Claims Commission and the claim involves a*
34 *contract with a state agency, board, commission or institution of higher*
35 *education or the claim exceeds ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) that such*
36 *agency, board, commission or institution of higher education file a written*

1 report thereof to the Litigation Subcommittee of the Legislative Council.
2 Such a report shall include a concise statement of facts with an explanation
3 of the agency's liability. Provided further, such report shall be filed with
4 the Litigation Subcommittee within thirty (30) days after the claim has been
5 adjudicated by the State Claims Commission.

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7 *SECTION 17. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS.* Disbursement of funds authorized
8 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
9 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
10 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
11 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
12 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
13 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
14 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
15 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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17 *SECTION 18. LEGISLATIVE INTENT.* It is the intent of the General Assembly
18 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
19 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
20 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
21 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
22 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
23 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
24 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

25
26 *SECTION 19. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.* It is found and determined by the General
27 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of
28 the Arkansas State Claims Commission are, due to unforeseen circumstances,
29 insufficient for the Arkansas State Claims Commission to continue to provide
30 essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide
31 the necessary monies for the Arkansas State Claims Commission to continue
32 such services; and that the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond
33 the date of its passage and approval could work irreparable harm upon the
34 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
35 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
36 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and

1 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its
2 passage and approval.

3 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become
4 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor
5 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
6 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides
7 the veto.
