4	(C) Include a statement of the geographic features that
5	cause it to be in the best interest of the students of the area for the
6	boundaries to be adjusted.
7	(3) The petition shall be accompanied by:
8	(A) Proof that the petitioners have caused public notice
9	to be published in a local newspaper of general circulation in each affected
10	school district no fewer than once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks; and
11	(B)(i) Proof that the petitioners have provided a copy of
12	the public notice to the boards of directors of the affected school districts
13	by registered mail or by certified mail with return receipt requested.
14	(ii) The notice to the boards of directors of the
15	affected school districts must be made at least ten (10) days before a
16	regularly scheduled meeting of each board of directors.
17	(4)(A) The petition shall be filed with the state board no
18	earlier than January 1 and no later than March 1 in any calendar year.
19	(B) The petition shall not be filed with the state board
20	until after the boards of directors of the affected school districts have
21	been notified and have had an opportunity to discuss the proposal at a
22	regularly scheduled board meeting.
23	(b) The petition shall be presented for hearing before the state board
24	at the first regularly scheduled meeting occurring after April 1 of the year
25	in which the petition was filed.
26	(c)(l) If the state board determines that due to geographic features
27	the proposed change in boundaries is in the best interest of the students of
28	the area, the state board may, by approval of a majority of the members of a
29	quorum present of the state board, issue an order changing or adjusting the
30	boundary lines between the adjoining districts.
31	(2) Before approving a boundary change, the state board shall
32	also consider the financial consequences of the proposed boundary change and
33	whether the change will result in identifiable boundaries.
34	(3) The state board shall not order any change in school
35	district boundaries which hampers, delays, or in any manner negatively
36	affects the desegregation efforts of the public school districts in the State

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1	of Arkansas.
2	(d) A change or adjustment in boundary lines approved under this
3	section shall be effective on July 1 of the year in which the petition was
4	<u>filed.</u>
5	(e)(1) Upon an order from the state board to change or adjust boundary
6	lines, the state board shall file the order with the county clerk in each
7	county in which every affected school district lies.
8	(2) The county clerk shall make a permanent record of the order,
9	and thereafter the boundaries so established shall be the boundaries of the
10	affected districts until changes are made according to the provisions of law.
11	(f) Upon an order from the state board to change or adjust boundary
12	lines, it shall be the duty of the Department of Education to make changes in
13	the maps of the school districts of the county to show the changes of
14	boundaries.
