26	WHEREAS, under Mr. Pickens' leadership, the Arkansas Department of
27	Economic Development has reached new heights in recruiting businesses to
28	Arkansas and creating jobs; and

30	WHEREAS, Mr. Pickens worked for more than forty (40) years for the
31	Arkansas Power & Light Company, now Entergy Corporation, where he served as
32	Vice President of Public Affairs, the Director of State Governmental and
33	External Affairs, and in other management positions; and

35	WHEREAS, Mr. Pickens has been active in the community currently serving
36	as the Chairman of Pathfinders Foundation, Vice Chairman of P.A.R.K.

(Positive Atmosphere Reaches Kids), and on the C.A.R.T.I. Foundation Board, 1 2 the Arkansas Sports Hall of Fame Board, the Little Rock Club Board, and the 3 Arkansas State Golf Association Executive Board; and 4 5 WHEREAS, Mr. Pickens previously served on the Arkansas State University 6 Board of Trustees; as President of the Arkansas State Golf Association; on 7 the U.A.L.R.
