8 **SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

9 TO PROVIDE THAT THE SECOND EXTRAORDINARY SESSION  
10 OF THE EIGHTY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY SHALL ENTER  
11 INTO RECESS AT THE CLOSE OF BUSINESS IN EACH  
12 HOUSE ON FEBRUARY 6, 2004, TO RECONVENE AT 12:00  
13 NOON ON THURSDAY, MARCH 4, 2004, FOR THE PURPOSE  
14 OF CONSIDERING VETOES, CORRECTING ERRORS,  
15 OVERSIGHTS AND OMISSIONS, AND TO CONSIDER OTHER  
16 MATTERS INCLUDED IN THE EXECUTIVE PROCLAMATION  
17 WHICH CALLED THE SECOND EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF  
18 THE EIGHTY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

21 TO PROVIDE THAT THE SECOND EXTRAORDINARY  
22 SESSION OF THE EIGHTY-FOURTH GENERAL  
23 ASSEMBLY SHALL ENTER INTO RECESS AT THE  
24 CLOSE OF BUSINESS IN EACH HOUSE ON  
25 FEBRUARY 6, 2004, TO RECONVENE AT 12:00  
26 NOON ON THURSDAY, MARCH 4, 2004.

28 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE  
29 STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

31 The Second Extraordinary Session of the Eighty-Fourth General Assembly  
32 shall enter into recess at the close of business in each house on February 6,  
33 2004, to reconvene at 12:00 noon on Thursday, March 4, 2004, for the purpose  
34 of considering vetoes, correcting errors, oversights and omissions, and to  
35 consider other matters included in the Executive Proclamation which called  
36 the Second Extraordinary Session of the Eighty-Fourth General Assembly.
