30	WHEREAS, Joslyn married Earnest R. Rocker, Senior, the father of her
31	only son, Earnest R. Rocker, Junior of Little Rock, Arkansas; and

33	WHEREAS, Joslyn relocated to Little Rock in 1989 and became a member of
34	St. John Missionary Baptist Church; and

36	WHEREAS, Joslyn was an employee of Philander Smith College as an

2	at the time of her death; and

4	WHEREAS, Joslyn adored the game of tennis and participated in matches
5	as often as time permitted; and

7	WHEREAS, Joslyn was preceded in death by her father, William Wright,
8	and a brother, Hansel Swanigan; she is survived by her mother, Vivian
9	Swanigan of North Little Rock, Arkansas; her son, Ernest; a brother, Lovell
10	Swanigan, III of Chicago, Illinois; one aunt, Barbara Jacobs of Chicago,
11	Illinois; a niece, Nicole Trice of Charlottesville, Virginia; Curtis King of
