17 WHEREAS, on January 2, 2004, Mark A. Moseley of Jasper, Arkansas, died  
18 near Harrison at the age of sixty-six (66); and

20 WHEREAS, Mr. Moseley was born July 24, 1937, in Russellville, Arkansas,  
21 the son of Bedford M. Moseley and Mary Sue (Littleton) Moseley; and

23 WHEREAS, Mr. Moseley was a veteran of the United States Air Force; and

25 WHEREAS, Mr. Moseley worked for the National Park Service for thirty-  
26 seven (37) years in Arizona, New Mexico, Washington, Wyoming, and Arkansas;

29 WHEREAS, Mr. Moseley moved to Newton County, Arkansas, in 1976 and  
30 worked as a park ranger there until his retirement in 1999; and

32 WHEREAS, Mr. Moseley also served as a Pruitt district ranger for  
33 fifteen (15) years, and had 2001 tactical baton certification as well as  
34 numerous other self-defense certifications; and

36 WHEREAS, Mr. Moseley was active in the Drug Abuse Resistance Education



1 ("DARE") program at area schools, and was a firearms instructor; and

3 WHEREAS, in 2000, Mr. Moseley went to work as a security guard for  
4 Superior Security Service in Harrison and was a visitor protection specialist  
5 at the Boone County federal building;

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Moseley was preceded in death by his mother, Mary Sue  
8 (Littleton) Jordan; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Moseley was married to his surviving spouse, Inas  
11 (Raulston) Watson, on January 1, 1991, in Eureka Springs; and

13 WHEREAS, Mr. Moseley is also survived by his son, Matthew Moseley and  
14 wife, Beth of Dardanelle; son, Andrew Moseley of Seattle, Washington; son,  
15 Larry Watson of Jasper; son, Rick Watson and wife, Jamie of Harrison;  
16 brother, Richard Moseley and sister, Sue Ann Bowers of Bartlett, Tennessee;  
17 grandchildren, Ryan and Kayla Watson, Adriann and Camden Watson, Lauren Beth  
18 Moseley; and four (4) other grandchildren,
