4	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 19-5-1121, resulting from Initiated Act 1		
5	of 2000, is amended to read as follows:		
6	19-5-1121. Medicaid Expansion Program Account.		
7	(a) There is hereby established on the books of the Treasurer of		
8	State, the Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a fund		
9	to be known as the Medicaid Expansion Program Account.		
10	(b)(1) This fund shall consist of those moneys transferred from the		
11	Tobacco Settlement Program Fund as provided in § 19-12-108 and interest		
12	earnings.		
13	(2) The fund shall be used by the:		
14	(A) By the Department of Human Services for those purposes		
15	as set out in § 19-12-112; and		
16	(B) As appropriated by the General Assembly for use in		
17	providing primary medical, dental, and mental health services and		
18	preventative health services to the uninsured and medically underserved		
19	Arkansans by community-owned and governed nonprofit organizations deemed		
20	qualified health centers under 42 U.S.C. § 254b, as in effect on January 1,		
21	<u>2005</u> .

23	SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
24	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that many Arkansans are in need of		
25	primary medical, dental, and mental health treatment and preventative health		
26	services and are not covered by health insurance or eligible for Medicaid or		
27	Medicare; that qualified community health centers provide needed care for		
28	many of these citizens but are in need of funding in order to continue		
29	offering necessary medical services; that this act will permit the use of		
30	available funds for those services; and that this act is necessary in order		
31	to provide needed funding for the next fiscal biennium. Therefore, an		
32	emergency is declared to exist and this act being necessary for the		
33	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective		
34	on July 1, 2005.		
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
