Stricken language would be deleted from and underlined language would be added to the law as it existed prior to this session of the General Assembly.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE SCOPE OF AGGRIEVED PARTIES AND THE LIMITATION OF CAUSES OF ACTION IN ACTIONS CONCERNING ANY ACT OR OMISSION OF A HOME INSPECTOR; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT TO AMEND THE SCOPE OF AGGRIEVED PARTIES AND THE LIMITATION OF CAUSES OF ACTION IN ACTIONS CONCERNING ANY ACT OR OMISSION OF A HOME INSPECTOR.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-52-320(a), concerning the scope of aggrieved parties and the limitation of causes of action, is amended to read as follows:
(a) Any cause of action to recover damages suffered by a consumer person as a result of any act or omission of a home inspector relating to a home inspection report must be commenced within one (1) year three (3) years from the date the report is completed.
