- 2 (a) Subject to confirmation by the Governor, the State Board of
- 3 Education is empowered to employ a person to act as the <del>Director</del> Commissioner
- 4 of Education and who shall be the administrative head of the Department of
- 5 Education, who. The commissioner shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor.
- 6 (b) The <u>director commissioner</u> shall devote all of his or her time to
- 7 the duties of his or her office, shall act as an agent of the board, and
- 8 perform other duties as are designated by the board and by statute.
- 9 (c)(1) The person selected as the <u>director commissioner</u> must:
