28	$\underline{\text{in immediate need of start-up funding for the administration and organization}}$

30	July 1, 2005, in order for the program to begin benefiting needy Arkansans	
31	and to meet the state fiscal year budgeting requirements. Therefore, an	
32	emergency is declared to exist and this act being necessary for the	
33	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective	
34	on July 1, 2005.
