27	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department	
28	of Education, to be payable from the Department of Education Public School	
29	Fund Account, for grants and aids to local school districts and special

31	addition to those funds appropriated in Section 1 of Act 2131 of 2005, the

2 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 3 4 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 5 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 6 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 7 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 8 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 9 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 10

SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

21 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 22 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the grants and aids 23 to local school districts and special programs of the Department of Education 24 in Act 2131 of 2005 are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for 25 the Department of Education to provide State assistance for the Arkansas 26 Teacher of the Year award; that the provisions of this act will provide the 27 necessary monies for the Department of Education to provide State assistance 28 to the Arkansas public school district that is the employer of the recipient 29 of the Arkansas Teacher of the Year award; and that a delay in the effective 30 date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is 31 32 hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate 33 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force 34 and effect from and after July 1, 2006.
