SECTION 7. APPROPRIATION - HONORING ARKANSAS' WAR HEROES. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education - Educational Television Division, to be payable from the Educational Television Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses for the "Honoring Arkansas' War

SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 10 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 11 PROMOTIONAL ITEMS. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall establish 12 upon request for the Department of Education - Educational Television 13 Division a special appropriation line item not to exceed \$25,000 each fiscal 14 year to be used in the acquisition of promotional items. When the Department 15 of Education - Educational Television Division wishes to transfer monies from 16 its operating expenses appropriation to the promotional items line, for 17 Educational Purposes the AETN Commission shall approve the request and forward it to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State for processing and for 18 19 prior approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. 20 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 21 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year 22 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 23 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 24 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 25 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly 26 has determined that the Department of Education - Educational Television 27 Division may operate more efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the 28 Department of Education - Educational Television Division authorizing broad 29 powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate 30 that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by this 31 32 section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint 33 Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement 34 of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled 35 unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is 36 void.

1 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005 2 2007 through June 30, 2007 2009. 3 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 4 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. HONORING 5 6 ARKANSAS' WAR HEROES. The appropriation authorized in this Act for Honoring 7 Arkansas' War Heroes is authorized for the 2007-2009 biennium only and is not 8 intended to be carried forward into the base level for the purposes of biennial budget preparation for the 2009-2011 biennium. Any appropriation 9 10 request for this purpose for the 2009-2011 biennium shall be considered a new 11 appropriation request, and therefore will be considered a change level budget 12 request. Notwithstanding any law pertaining to the transfer of year-end fund 13 balances or any law to the contrary, any funds provided to the Educational 14 15 Television Fund Account for the purpose of funding the Honoring Arkansas' War 16 Heroes Appropriation which remain in the Education Television Fund Account at 17 the end of a fiscal year shall remain in the Educational Television Fund Account and shall continue to be allocated to the Honoring Arkansas' War 18 19 Heroes Appropriation in the following fiscal year. 20 21 SECTION 10. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 22 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 23 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 24 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 25 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 26 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 27 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 28 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 29 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 30 SECTION 11. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 31 32 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 33 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 34 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 35 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 36 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral

1	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
2	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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4	SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
5	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
6	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
7	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of
8	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
9	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
10	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
11	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
12	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
13	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
14	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
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
