- 31 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 32 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
- 33 APPROPRIATION RESTRICTIONS LAND ACQUISITION. In no event shall any funds
- 34 appropriated to the War Memorial Stadium Commission be used for the
- 35 acquisition of real estate without the prior review and approval of the
- 36 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.

FISCAL YEARS

1	Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
2	appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
3	is the function of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
4	delineating such maximums as the appropriation in the appropriation act(s)
5	for a state agency and the general revenue allocations authorized for each
6	fund and fund account by amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law.
7	Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly
8	maintain oversight be requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or
9	Joint Budget Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of
10	approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a
11	severable part of this section. If the requirement of approval be the
12	Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a
13	court of competent jurisdiction, then the authority of the Commission to
14	acquire real estate is void.
15	The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007
16	through June 30, 2009.

18	SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
19	authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
20	and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
21	the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
22	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
23	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
24	control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
25	the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
26	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

28	SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
29	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
30	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
31	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
32	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
33	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
34	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or

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Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

1	SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
2	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
3	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
4	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of
5	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
6	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
7	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
8	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
9	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
10	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
11	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
