- hazard mitigation fund, which shall be separate and apart from the Governor's
  standard emergency fund.
- 3 (2) The initial amount of the disaster response fund shall be in the 4 amount of one million dollars (\$1,000,000), the disaster recovery fund shall

- 2 (3) Transfer the direction, personnel, or functions of state departments 3 and agencies or units thereof for the purpose of performing or facilitating 4 emergency services;
- 5 (4) Subject to any applicable requirements for compensation under § 12-6 75-124, commandeer or utilize any private property if he or she finds this necessary to cope with the disaster emergency;
- 8 (5) Direct and compel the evacuation of all or part of the population 9 from any stricken or threatened area within the state if the Governor deems 10 this action necessary for the preservation of life or other disaster 11 mitigation, response, or recovery;
- 12 (6) Prescribe routes, modes of transportation, and destinations in connection with evacuation;
- 14 (7) Control ingress and egress to and from a disaster area, the movement 15 of persons within the area, and the occupancy of premises therein;
- 16 (8) Suspend or limit the sale, dispensing, or transportation of 17 alcoholic beverages, firearms, explosives, and combustibles; and
- 18 (9) Make provision for the availability and use of temporary emergency housing.

21 SECTION 87. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 22 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 23 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 24 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 25 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 26 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 27 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 28 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be

strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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SECTION 88. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral

| 4  | SECTION 89. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General       |
| 5  | Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the        |
| 6  | appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the          |
| 7  | effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of    |
