HOUSE BILL 1596

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## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL  
10 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE ARKANSAS  
11 DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT; AND FOR  
12 OTHER PURPOSES.  
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## Subtitle

15 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF  
16 EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT REAPPROPRIATION.  
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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22 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - EOC CONSTRUCTION. There is hereby  
23 appropriated, to the Arkansas Department of Emergency Management, to be  
24 payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund  
25 accounts, for the Arkansas Department of Emergency Management, the following:

26 (A) Effective July 1, 2007, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
27 Section 1 of Act 1848 of 2005, for construction of a new State Emergency  
28 Operations Center (EOC), in a sum not to exceed .....\$1,143,750.  
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30 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - FEDERAL. There is hereby appropriated, to the  
31 Arkansas Department of Emergency Management, to be payable from the federal  
32 funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for the  
33 Arkansas Department of Emergency Management, the following:

34 (A) Effective July 1, 2007, the balance of the appropriation provided in  
35 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 228 of 2005, for construction of the ADEM  
36 Emergency Operations Center, in a sum not to exceed .....\$3,431,250.



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SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - CASH FUND. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Department of Emergency Management, to be payable from the cash fund deposited in the State Treasury as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for the Arkansas Department of Emergency Management, the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2007, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 3 of Act 120 of 2005, for construction and other associated costs of a primary Emergency Operations Center, in a sum not to exceed .....\$450,000.

SECTION 4. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

(B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral

1 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
2 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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4 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
5 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
6 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that previous  
7 General Assemblies have provided appropriations for the projects provided or  
8 enumerated in this act; that certain appropriations will expire before the  
9 adjournment of the General Assembly; and that if such appropriations expire,  
10 the projects and programs authorized herein will cease thereby depriving the  
11 citizens of the State of the benefits to be derived from such projects.  
12 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
13 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
14 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its  
15 passage and approval. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the  
16 Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time  
17 during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the  
18 Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date  
19 the last house overrides the veto.
