BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-37-303(a), concerning the notice sent regarding worthless checks, is amended to read as follows:
(a) For purposes of this section and § 5-37-304, notice that payment was refused by the drawee for lack of funds shall be sent by certified mail, registered mail evidenced by return receipt, or by regular mail supported by an affidavit of mailing, to the address printed on the instrument or given at the time of issuance or to the current residence.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 5-37-303(b)(2), concerning the contents of an affidavit of mailing of notice of insufficient funds, is amended to read as follows:
(2) If notice is sent by an affidavit of mailing, the The affidavit of mailing shall contain a copy of the notice and shall substantially state:
"Affidavit of Mailing

I am over the age of eighteen (18) years and on
(date), I mailed notice of insufficient funds under Arkansas Code § 5-37-303 to the addressee set forth below in an official depository under the exclusive care and custody of the United States Postal Service in
