## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO MODIFY THE UNIFORM DATE FOR THE BEGINNING OF THE SCHOOL YEAR; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO MODIFY THE UNIFORM DATE FOR THE BEGINNING OF THE SCHOOL YEAR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-10-106(a)(1), concerning the beginning date for the school year, is amended to read as follows:
(a) (1)(A) In each school year, the first day of the school year for student attendance in the public elementary and secondary schools of the State of Arkansas shall begin no earlier than August $19 \underline{12}$ and no later than August 26.
(B) If, however, August $18 \underline{11}$ falls on a Monday, school may begin on that date.
(C) The date for beginning the school year shall be determined by the board of directors of the school district.
(D) Labor Day shall be celebrated as a school holiday in all the school districts of the state, and school shall not be held on that date.
