SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 27 28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 29 DIRECTOR'S OFFICE/OFFICE OF CHIEF COUNSEL - PURCHASE OF EVIDENCE. Upon 30 approval by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the Chief Counsel for the Department of Health and Human Services may transfer an amount up to but not 31 32 to exceed \$12,000 for the 2007-2009 biennial period and deposit same in a 33 bank account for the purpose of purchasing evidence in the course of 34 investigating the illegal use of food stamps/Electronic Benefit Transfer 35 (EBT) cards. The funds so transferred shall be subject to accounting in a 36 manner substantially similar to that employed by the Arkansas State Police

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1 for such transactions; provided however, that information tending to identify 2 participants in such transactions shall be exempt from the Arkansas Freedom 3 of Information Act.

4 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007

7 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. HUMAN 9 SERVICES RENOVATION FUND. Department of Human Services Renovation Fund. 10 (a) There is established on the books of the Treasurer of State, Auditor of 11 State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a fund to be known as the 12 Department of Human Services Renovation Fund.

(b) This fund shall be used for constructing, acquiring, renovating,
maintaining, repairing, and equipping facilities of the Department of Health
and Human Services and for paying disallowances by the federal government.
(c) The fund shall consist of:

17 (1) Federal reimbursement received by the Department of Health and Human Services and deposited in the various fund accounts of the department; and 18 19 (2) General revenues transferred from the Division of Youth Services, the 20 Division of Behavioral Health, and the Division of Developmental Disabilities 21 Services, and the Division of Health for the purposes of repairing, 22 renovating, equipping, acquiring and constructing Department of Health and 23 Human Services facilities with an annual maximum of five million dollars 24 (\$5,000,000). The projects for which these transfers are authorized must be 25 projects which were unanticipated during the preceding regular session of the 26 Arkansas General Assembly and must be projects which, if not carried out in 27 the interim period between regular sessions of the Arkansas General Assembly 28 would cause greater harm to the facilities, clients or programs of the 29 Department of Health and Human Services than to wait until the next regular 30 session.

(3) Other non-general revenue funds as may be available within the Department of Health and Human Services that can be used for the purposes of this fund. (d)(1) At the request of the Director of the Department of Health and Human Services, and upon certification of the availability of such funds, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall initiate the necessary transfer documents to reflect the transfer on the books of record of the Treasurer of State, the

1 Auditor of State, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, and the Department 2 of Health and Human Services.

3 (2) The Director of the Department of Health and Human Services shall submit
4 any transfer plan to and must receive approval of the plan from the Chief
5 Fiscal Officer of the State, the Governor and the Arkansas Legislative
6 Council prior to the effective date of the transfer.

7 (e) Provided, that any non-general revenue funding that may remain in the 8 fund at the end of any fiscal year shall be carried over into the next fiscal 9 year and all obligated general revenue funding that may remain in the fund at 10 the end of any fiscal year shall be carried over into the next fiscal year to 11 satisfy such legal and contractual obligations that have been entered into 12 prior to the end of the fiscal year.

(f) Determining the amount of funds appropriated to a state agency is the 13 14 prerogative of the General Assembly and is usually accomplished by 15 delineating specific line items and by identifying the appropriation and 16 funding attached to that line item. The General Assembly has determined that 17 the Department of Health and Human Services could be operated more efficiently if some flexibility is given to that agency. That flexibility is 18 19 being accomplished by providing transfer authority in subsection (d) of this section, and since the General Assembly has granted the agency broad powers 20 21 under the transfer authority concept, it is both necessary and appropriate 22 that the General Assembly maintain oversight of the utilization of the 23 transfer authority by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council in 24 the utilization of this transfer authority. Therefore, the requirement of 25 approval by the Legislative Council is not a severable part of this section. 26 If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council is ruled 27 unconstitutional by a court jurisdiction, this entire section is void. 28 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007 29 2009 through June 30, 2009 2010.

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31 SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 32 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 33 AUTHORITY. The Director of the Department of Health and Human Services shall 34 have transfer authority provided by the following:

35 (a) DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES RENOVATION FUND. The Director of the
 36 Department of Health and Human Services is authorized to request fund

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1 transfers according to the provisions established by Arkansas Code Ann. 19-5-2 1020, Department of Human Services Renovation Fund, as amended herein; and (b) MATCH TRANSFER. The Director of the Department of Health and Human 3 4 Services, with the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, is 5 authorized to effect inter-agency and inter-divisional fund transfers for the 6 purpose of providing the State's matching share for payments made to that 7 Division or Office or its service providers for services eligible for federal 8 reimbursement under programs administered by the Department of Health and 9 Human Services. The Department of Health and Human Services shall report to 10 the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee on a quarterly basis all 11 fund transfers made in accordance with the authority granted by this section; 12 and

13 (c) YOUTH SERVICES - HOUSING AND SEPARATION APPROPRIATION PROVISIONS. The Division of Youth Services (DYS) is authorized to fulfill its responsibility 14 15 to house offenders between the ages of 18 and 21 and to separate juvenile 16 offenders by age and seriousness of offense by either employing additional 17 state employees and providing the corresponding operating expenses or entering into professional services contracts. If the Division of Youth 18 19 Services determines that the Division needs to employ state employees to fulfill the housing and separation requirements, they may transfer up to the 20 21 total amount appropriated for the DYS - Residential Services Program 22 appropriation to the appropriate DYS appropriation and line items, upon 23 approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, and prior review by the 24 Legislative Council; and

25 (d) REALLOCATION OF RESOURCES: (1) The Department of Health and Human 26 Services (DHHS) (DHS) provides hundreds of different services to over 1 27 million Arkansans. The specific mix of service needs and the funding and 28 staffing required to provide them can vary significantly based on many 29 factors, including natural disasters, changing federal mandates and funding 30 sources, demographic shifts, fluctuating court-ordered services, social trends, and job market variations such as nursing shortages. The impact of 31 32 these factors through the course of a biennium make it very difficult for the 33 Department to accurately predict the exact needs for funding, appropriation 34 and positions in each of its over 100 different appropriations. To ensure 35 that it can respond quickly to changing client needs and make the most 36 effective use of the resources allocated to it, the Department of Health and

1 Human Services shall be authorized to utilize the reallocation of resource 2 authority to make the proper adjustments to the budgets within the Department. Therefore, upon determination by the Director of the Department 3 4 of Health and Human Services that a reallocation of resources within the 5 department is necessary for the efficient and effective operation of the 6 department, the director, with approval of the Governor, shall have the 7 authority to request, from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, a transfer 8 of positions, appropriations, line item appropriations, and funds within or 9 between existing and newly created divisions, offices, sections, or units of the department. Provided, however, that no transfer of funds or appropriation 10 11 that provides direct support or matching support for the Arkansas Medicaid Program shall be made to any other fund account or appropriation that does 12 13 not directly support the Arkansas Medicaid Program. Further, no positions, funds, or appropriation authorized during the 2007-2009 biennial budget 14 15 process for the Division of Children and Family Services compliance with 16 initiatives established under the Angela R. consent decree shall be 17 transferred to any other division. Nothing in this provision is intended to prevent the one-time transfers of savings in any other program to the 18 19 Arkansas Medicaid Program, with the exception of the provisions previously 20 cited for the Division of Children and Family Services - Angela R. consent 21 decree. The Division of Developmental Disabilities - Grants to Community 22 Providers line item of the Developmental Disabilities Services - Grants-in-23 Aid appropriation may not be decreased. The appropriation, funding, and 24 positions provided for the six Human Development Centers shall remain at a 25 level sufficient to ensure quality care for the Centers' residents. The 26 exemptions provided in this subsection whereby certain DHHS DHS Programs and 27 Divisions are protected from appropriation, fund, or position transfers are 28 applicable only to the reallocation or transfer authority granted herein, and 29 not by any reductions which are applicable to all state programs. 30 The Director of the Department of Health and Human Services shall submit any 31 requests for transfers to and must receive approval of the requests for 32 transfers from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the Governor, and the 33 Arkansas Legislative Council prior to the effective date of the transfers. 34 Provided, however, that the Department of Health and Human Services shall be 35 limited to submitting no more than four requests for reallocation of resources transfers two reallocation of resources transfer requests during 36

any fiscal year. In each Departmental request no single division will request
 reallocation for more than one purpose as listed in this section. Transfer
 authority for unforeseen purposes shall further be limited to no more than 5%

4 of the total appropriation, funding, and positions authorized for the5 Department. Reallocation of resources transfers may include multiple items

6 but shall be limited to the following purposes:

7 i). Medicaid Program

8 ii). Facilities and institutions costs, including operational expenses and9 construction/renovation/equipping expenses

10 iii). Departmental grants and contracts

11 iv). Court ordered settlements and payments

v). Payment of administrative expenses, including but not limited to,
overtime and other costs of personnel for critical services or functions
necessary to carry out the mission of the agency

15 vi). Restructuring efforts as deemed necessary to comply with new and/or 16 unanticipated federal or state mandates

17 vii). Redirecting internal resources, both direct and/or indirect, to meet
18 client needs and services

19 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 20 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year 21 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 22 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 23 24 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly has 25 determined that the Department of Health and Human Services may operate more 26 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Health and 27 Human Services authorizing broad powers under the Reallocation of Resources 28 provisions herein. Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate that the 29 General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of the 30 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by this section. 31 The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget 32 Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement of 33 approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled 34 unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is 35 void.

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(2) If it is determined that the requested reallocation of resources

1 transfers should be made, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall then 2 initiate the necessary transfer documents to reflect the transfers upon the fiscal records of the Treasurer of State, the Auditor of State, the Chief 3 4 Fiscal Officer of the State, and the Department of Health and Human Services. 5 In addition, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, together with the Co-6 Chairpersons of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, may 7 approve, on an emergency basis, requests for utilization of this Section 8 without prior approval of the Arkansas Legislative Council, with any such 9 actions reported at the next meeting of the Arkansas Legislative Council. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007 10 11 2009 through June 30, 2009 2010.

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13 SECTION 22. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 14 NURSING/DIRECT CARE EDUCATION STIPEND PROGRAM. Special provision for a 15 16 Nursing/Direct Care Education Stipend Program for the Department of Health 17 and Human Services is hereby authorized to pay from State and Federal Funds appropriated in each division Act. This program is for eligible nursing 18 19 students who are attending accredited nursing institutions to become Registered or Licensed Practical Nurses, as well as Certified Nursing 20 21 Assistants, Life Skills Trainers and Mental Health Workers. 22 The stipend is \$5,000 per person per year. Any student who is awarded and 23 accepts a stipend is under employment commitment to the respective DHHS DHS 24 Division and is required to work for that division, in a full-time employee 25 status effective immediately upon graduation. The student employment 26 commitment is equal to the number of years the stipend was awarded and 27 accepted. In the event of Employee/Student default of the employment 28 commitment, the Employee/Student will be considered in breach of contract and 29 repayment of the stipend will be required as specified in the Stipend 30 Contract. 31 Each division participating in the Education Stipend Program shall determine 32 on an annual basis, the number of student stipends available. 33 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 34 2007 2009 through June 30, 2009 2010. 35 SECTION 23. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 36

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1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SELL, 2 LEASE, RENT, CONVEY OR ENCUMBER RAY WINDER FIELD. In no event shall the Department of Health and Human Services, or any of its governing boards, 3 4 sell, lease, rent, convey or encumber the land and facilities of Ray Winder 5 Field in Little Rock, Arkansas without the prior review and approval of the 6 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.

SECTION 24. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 9 10 NURSING/DIRECT CARE RECRUITMENT/RETENTION BONUSES. Special provision to 11 provide Nursing/Direct Care Recruitment and Retention Bonuses for the Department of Health and Human Services is hereby authorized to pay from 12 13 State and Federal funds appropriated for each respective division. 14 Nursing/direct care service recruitment/retention bonuses are in addition to 15 the maximum annual amounts provided in the Regular Salaries Section of the 16 respective Division Act for Registered Nurse, Licensed Practical Nurse, 17 Certified Nursing Assistant, Life Skills Trainer and Mental Health Worker. New hire nurses must be licensed by the Arkansas State Board of Nursing. The 18 19 total recruitment/retention bonus payment commitment for eligible nurses 20 shall not exceed \$4,000 per Registered Nurse and \$2,000 per Licensed 21 Practical Nurse and \$1,000 per Certified Nursing Assistant, Life Skills 22 Trainer and Mental Health Worker. The lump sum bonus payments and employment commitment to the State will be made in partial payments as follows: 23 24
