If there is not sufficient appropriation, from funds deposited in the State Treasury or Cash Accounts of an agency, for 10 11 personal services, or personal services matching for any state agency for the biennial period ending June 30, 2009 2010, for State agencies that process 12 payroll through the Arkansas Administrative Statewide Information System for 13 14 federal and state tax reporting as necessary to comply with the payment of 15 stipends under United States Internal Revenue Code (IRC), 2001-Code-Vol, Sec 16 3401 and Treasury Regulations 31.3401(c)-1(a) and 1.1402(c)-2(b), and 17 others which govern the reporting of income and payment of withholding and matching taxes for personal services, the agency shall request a transfer 18 19 from appropriation provided for Personal Services and Personal Services 20 Matching in the appropriation for Various State Agencies - U.S. IRC and 21 Treasury Regulations herein, from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, 22 stating clearly the amounts required for each item. Upon approval of the 23 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the State Auditor shall be notified as to 24 the amount and the purposes for which the appropriation is to be made and 25 such appropriation as needed shall be established upon the books of the 26 Department of Finance and Administration and the State Auditor. Provided, 27 however, that in the event the total amount of transfer requested in any 28 fiscal year exceeds Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), the Chief Fiscal Officer 29 of the State shall seek prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or 30 Joint Budget Committee before the transfer shall be made. 31 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007 32 2009 through June 30, <del>2009</del> 2010. 33 SECTION 74. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 34 35 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. POSITION

ESTABLISHMENT. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall have the authority

- 1 to establish such positions as necessary for State agencies to process
- 2 payroll through the Arkansas Administrative Statewide Information System for
- 3 federal and state tax reporting purposes as necessary to comply with the
- 4 United States Internal Revenue Code (IRC), 2001-Code-Vol, Sec 3401 and
- 5 Treasury Regulations  $\S31.3401(c)-1(a)$  and  $\S1.1402(c)-2(b)$ , and others which
- 6 govern the reporting of income and payment of withholding and matching taxes
- 7 for personal services. The positions established shall not be considered as
- 8 part of the total number of authorized positions for an agency and shall only
- 9 be considered as placeholders for payments to individuals who are board or
- 10 commission members or elected officials of the State that do not otherwise
- 11 receive salaries or wages as defined in §19-4-521 for their personal
- 12 services. Further, none of the positions established under this section
- 13 shall imply eligibility for state retirement of state health insurance
- 14 benefits. The establishment of such positions shall not exceed 250 positions
- 15 in any fiscal year.

- 17 SECTION 75. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 18 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
- 19 AUTHORIZED. The Arkansas Children's Hospital may request the Chief Fiscal
- 20 Officer of the State to transfer the sum of not to exceed \$1,000,000 each
- 21 fiscal year from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account from funds made
- 22 available by this Act for the Arkansas Children's Hospital Burn Center to the
- 23 Department of Human Service Grants Fund Account. The transferred funds shall
- 24 be used to match federal funds used for supplemental Medicaid payments to
- 25 Arkansas Children's Hospital.

- 27 SECTION 76. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
- 29 INNOVATION AND PROJECT DEVELOPMENT FUND TRANSFERS. The Department of
- 30 Information Systems is a cost recovery agency subject to the requirements of
- 31 the United States Office of Management and Budget Circular A-87 Cost
- 32 Principles for State, Local and Indian Tribal Government (A-87) and Cost
- 33 Principles for Developing Cost Allocation Plans and Indirect Cost Rates for
- 34 Agreements with the Federal Government Implementation Guide for the Office of
- 35 Management and Budget Circular A-87 (ASMBC-10). To comply with these federal
- 36 rules, it is necessary to establish an Innovation and Project Development

- 1 appropriation and general revenue fund account within the Department of
- 2 Finance and Administration Disbursing Officer for the Department of
- 3 Information Systems. This fund shall be used for state enterprise innovation
- 4 projects that would enhance the technology operations of the Sate that cannot
- 5 be cost allocated to federal programs. The Department of Information Systems
- 6 will maintain documentation for projects billed for these purposes. Fund
- 7 transfers may be made from the General Revenue Fund Account, upon the
- 8 approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and prior review of the
- 9 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, to reimburse the
- 10 Department of Information Systems for the amounts billed.

- 12 SECTION 77. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 13 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. WORK
- 14 FORCE 2000 DISTRIBUTION. After the amounts to be made available to the
- 15 various technical institutes or comprehensive lifelong learning centers have
- 16 been determined as set out in Arkansas Code 26-51-205(d)(2), such documents
- 17 as may be necessary shall be processed so that funds may be transferred from
- 18 the Work Force 2000 Development Fund to the State Treasury fund or fund
- 19 account from which the technical institute or comprehensive lifelong learning
- 20 center draws its general revenue support. Such funds as may be transferred
- 21 shall not exceed 6.309% of the total funds available from the Work Force 2000
- 22 Development Fund during each fiscal year-of the biennial period ending June
- 23 <del>30, 2009</del>.
- In the event that a technical college, community college or educational
- 25 institution which receives support from the Work Force 2000 Development Fund
- 26 as determined by law transfers from the Arkansas Technical College and
- 27 Community College System for which Work Force 2000 Development Fund monies
- 28 are determined by law, then the actual amount of support from the Work Force
- 29 2000 Development Fund in the preceding fiscal year for such educational
- 30 institution shall be made available irrespective of any other provision of
- 31 law which sets out maximum levels of support from such fund.
- 32 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007
- 33 2009 through June 30, <del>2009</del> 2010.

- 35 SECTION 78. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
- 36 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds

1	made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
2	restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
3	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
4	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
5	control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
6	the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
7	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.
8	
9	SECTION 79. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
10	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
11	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
12	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
13	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
14	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
15	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
16	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
17	
18	SECTION 80. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
19	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
20	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
21	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
22	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
23	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
24	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
25	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
26	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
27	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
28	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
