7	related to brightness, intensity, luminous intensity, luminous efficacy, or

10	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-36-214(b), regarding fog lamps, is		
11	amended to read as follows:		
12	(b) Fog Lamps.		
13	(1) Any motor vehicle may be equipped with not more than two (2)		
14	fog lamps mounted on the front at a height not less than twelve inches (12")		
15	nor more than thirty inches (30") above the level surface upon which the		
16	motor vehicle stands.		
17	(2) The fog lamps shall be so aimed that when the $\underline{motor}$ vehicle		
18	is not loaded, none of the high-intensity portion of the light to the left of		
19	the center of the motor vehicle shall project, at a distance of twenty-five		
20	feet (25') ahead, project higher than a level of four inches (4") below the		
21	level of the center of the $\underline{\text{fog}}$ lamp from which it comes.		
22	(3) Lighted fog lamps meeting these requirements may be used		
23	with lower headlamp beams as specified in § 27-36-210(b)(2).		
24	(4) Fog lamps shall be used only during inclement weather.
