6	(E) Maintained in a condition ensuring that the writing is		
7	clearly legible.		
8	(3) The placement of any type of cover over a temporary		
9	cardboard buyer's tag that makes the tag more difficult to read is		
10	prohibited.		
11	(4) In the event a temporary cardboard buyer's tag is lost,		
12	mutilated, or becomes illegible, the buyer immediately shall apply for a		
13	replacement tag from the dealer, which shall expire upon the expiration date		
14	of the original temporary cardboard buyer's tag.
