## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO TRANSFER CERTAIN FUNDS TO THE RED RIVER  
10 WATERWAYS PROJECT TRUST FUND FROM THE GENERAL  
11 REVENUES OF THE STATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

14 TO TRANSFER CERTAIN FUNDS TO THE RED  
15 RIVER WATERWAYS PROJECT TRUST FUND FROM  
16 THE GENERAL REVENUES.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
20

21 Section 1. FUND TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of the  
22 act, or as soon thereafter as is practical, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the  
23 State shall transfer on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and  
24 the Auditor of the State the sum of three million dollars (\$3,000,000) from  
25 the General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund to the Red River Waterways Project  
26 Trust Fund to replace the total amount transferred to the General Revenue  
27 Fund Account from the Red River Waterways Project Trust Fund by Act 1 of  
28 2002.  
29

30 Section 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
31 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the state currently has a  
32 surplus of revenue and that these amount must transfer before expending funds  
33 for other purposes. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act  
34 being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health,  
35 and safety shall become effective on:

36 (1) The date of its approval by the Governor;



1           (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, the  
2 expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill;  
3 or

4           (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden,  
5 the date the last house overrides the veto.
