- dealer does not charge for the service of filling in the blanks or otherwise charge for preparing documents.
- 3 (b)(1) A used motor vehicle dealer may charge a service and handling 4 fee in connection with the sale or lease, or the modification, extension, or 5 renewal of the sale or lease, of a used motor vehicle for:
- 6 (A) The handling, processing, and storage of documents; 7 and
- 8 (B) Other administrative and clerical services.
- 9 (2)(A) The service and handling fee may be charged to allow cost 10 recovery for used motor vehicle dealers.
- 11 (B) A portion of the service and handling fee may result 12 in profit to the used motor vehicle dealer.
