9 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT THE APPLICATION PROCESS
10 FOR APPROVAL OF COSMETOLOGICAL SCHOOLS IN PUBLIC
11 EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS IS THE SAME APPLICATION
12 PROCESS THAT IS REQUIRED FOR APPROVAL OF ALL
13 OTHER COSMETOLOGICAL SCHOOLS; AND FOR OTHER
14 PURPOSES.

16 TO REQUIRE THAT THE APPLICATION PROCESS
17 FOR APPROVAL OF COSMETOLOGICAL SCHOOLS
18 IN PUBLIC EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS IS
19 THE SAME APPLICATION PROCESS THAT IS
20 REQUIRED FOR APPROVAL OF ALL OTHER
21 COSMETOLOGICAL SCHOOLS.

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

27 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-26-418, as amended by Section 26 of Act
28 4 of 2009, is amended to read as follows:

29 17-26-418. Cosmetology courses in public schools.

30 (a)(1) All public educational institutions operating cosmetological
31 schools shall comply with the standards, and rules, ~~and regulations~~
32 promulgated by the State Board of Health.

33 (2)(A) However, the responsibility for approval of
34 cosmetological schools in public educational institutions shall be the sole
35 responsibility of the State Board of Workforce Education and Career
36 Opportunities.



1 (B) In approving a cosmetological school in a public
2 educational institution, the State Board of Workforce Education and Career
3 Opportunities shall use the same application process and requirements as the
4 State Board of Health uses for approval of all other cosmetological schools.

5 (b) Such schools shall not be required to obtain a license as
6 prescribed in this chapter.

7 (c) Each person who successfully completes the courses in cosmetology
8 given in a school under the public school system of this state is eligible
9 for a license under this chapter the same as though he or she had graduated
10 from a licensed private school of cosmetology approved by the State Board of
11 Health. For this purpose, successful completion of courses in cosmetology
12 given in public schools equal to and the equivalent of the courses required
13 to be given in licensed private schools of cosmetology approved by the
14 ~~Department~~ State Board of Health shall be deemed to be the fulfillment of the
15 requirements of this chapter in regard to completion of courses in licensed
16 schools of cosmetology approved by the ~~department~~ State Board of Health.
