## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT BEFORE A LAW ENFORCEMENT VEHICLE IS SOLD FOR RESALE ALL LIGHTS, DECALS, LAW ENFORCEMENT RADIOS, SIRENS, AND OTHER ITEMS THAT ARE ASSOCIATED WITH LAW ENFORCEMENT VEHICLES SHALL BE REMOVED; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO PROVIDE THAT BEFORE A LAW ENFORCEMENT VEHICLE IS SOLD FOR RESALE ALL LIGHTS, DECALS, LAW ENFORCEMENT RADIOS, SIRENS, AND OTHER ITEMS THAT ARE ASSOCIATED WITH LAW ENFORCEMENT VEHICLES SHALL BE REMOVED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 5, Chapter 77, Subchapter 2 is amended to add a new section to read as follows:

5-7-204. Resale of law enforcement vehicles.
(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, before a law enforcement vehicle is offered for sale to the public, the seller of the law enforcement vehicle shall remove from the law enforcement vehicle the:
(1) Lightbar;
(2) Spotlight;
(3) Siren;
(4) Law enforcement decals and signage;
(5) Radios; and
(6) Other items associated solely with law enforcement vehicles. (b) The items required to be removed under subdivisions (a)(1) - (6) of this section are not required to be removed if the law enforcement vehicle is sold to a law enforcement agency.
(c) A violation of subsection (a) of this section is a violation and punishable by a fine of not more than one thousand dollars ( $\$ 1,000$ ).
