## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE PURPOSES OF THE PLANNING AND PREPARATION TIME A SCHOOL DISTRICT IS REQUIRED TO PROVIDE FOR CLASSROOM TEACHERS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO CLARIFY THE PURPOSES OF THE PLANNING AND PREPARATION TIME A SCHOOL DISTRICT IS REQUIRED TO PROVIDE FOR CLASSROOM TEACHERS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-17-114(a)(1), concerning the minimum amount of planning and preparation time a school district must provide a classroom teacher, is amended to read as follows:
(a)(1)(A) Effective beginning the 2003-2004 school year, each A school district in this state shall provide to each classroom teacher employed by the school district a minimum of two hundred (200) minutes each week for each teacher to schedule time for:
(i) conferences, Conferring with parents or

## guardians of students;

(ii) Collaborating with licensed and nonlicensed staff concerning student performance; and
(iii) instructional planning, and preparation for all classroom teachers employed by the school district Planning and preparing for classroom instruction.
(B) Planning time in excess of the minimum of two hundred (200) minutes may be scheduled by a school district for purposes relating to student achievement, assessment, and district-wide instructional planning.
