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35	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 17-95-306 is amended to read as follows:	
36	17-95-306 Criminal background check	

1	(a)(1) beginning July 1, 2005, every person applying for a license or	
2	renewal of a license issued by the Arkansas State Medical Board shall provide	
3	written authorization to the board to allow the Department of Arkansas State	
4	Police to release the results of a state and federal criminal history	
5	background check report to the board.	
6	(2) Beginning July 1, 2009, the following applicants shall	
7	provide written authorization to the board to allow the department to releas	
8	the results of a state and federal criminal history background check report	
9	to the board and to allow the board to release the results of a state and	
10	federal criminal history background check report to the credentialing	
11	information system offered by the board under § 17-95-107:	
12	(A) Every person applying for a license or renewal of a	
13	license issued by the board; and	
14	(B) Every person who is licensed by the board and is	
15	returning to the state after being out of state for more than one (1) year.	
16	(2)(3) The applicant shall be responsible for payment of pay the	
17	fees associated with the background checks.	
18	(b)(1) The state background check shall be from the Identification	
19	Bureau of the Department of Arkansas State Police.	
20	(2) The federal background check shall:	
21	(A) Be from the Federal Bureau of Investigation;	
22	(B) Conform to the applicable federal standards; and	
23	(C) Include the taking of fingerprints of the applicant.	
24	(c) Upon completion of the criminal background checks required by this	
25	section, the Identification Bureau of the Department of Arkansas State	
26	Police:	
27	(1) Shall forward to the board all releasable information	
28	obtained concerning the applicant; and	
29	(2) May retain the fingerprinting card of the applicant until	
30	notified by the board that the person is no longer licensed.	
31	(d) Upon receipt of the criminal background check report information	
32	from the Identification Bureau of the Department of Arkansas State Police,	
33	the board shall disclose the criminal background check report information to	
34	the credentialing information system offered by the board under $\S 17-95-107$.	
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36	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 17-95-309(a), concerning the sealing of	

1	background checks regarding physicians, is amended to read as forlows.	
2	17-95-309. Background records sealed.	
3	(a) Any background record received by the Arkansas State Medical Board	
4	from the Identification Bureau of the Department of Arkansas State Police	
5	shall not be available for examination except by:	
6	(1) An affected applicant for licensure or his or her authorized	
7	representative;	
8	(2) A credentialing organization utilizing the credentialing	
9	information system offered by the board under § 17-95-107;	
10	(2)(3) A person whose license is subject to revocation or his o	
11	her authorized representative.	
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
