15	WHEREAS, diseases of the heart are the nation's leading cause of death
16	and stroke is the third leading cause of death; and
17	
18	WHEREAS, cardiovascular disease claims the lives of nearly four hundred
19	fifty-five thousand (455,000) American women each year, which is
20	approximately one (1) death per minute; and
21	
22	WHEREAS, each year, fifty-three percent (53%) of all deaths due to
23	cardiovascular disease and sixty-one percent (61%) of stroke deaths occur in
24	women; and
25	
26	WHEREAS, in 2008, the direct and indirect cost of cardiovascular
27	diseases in the United States, including stroke, is estimated to be four
28	hundred seventy-five billion, three hundred million dollars
29	(\$475,300,000,000); and

31 32	WHEREAS, more women die of heart disease, stroke, and all other cardiovascular diseases than the next five (5) leading causes of death

34 35	WHEREAS, only twenty-one percent (21%) of women consider cardiovascular
36	disease their greatest health risk; and

1 2 WHEREAS, February is designated as American Heart Month; and 3 4 WHEREAS, Go Red For Women is the American Heart Association's national 5 call to increase awareness about heart disease, which is the leading cause of 6 death for women, and to inspire women to take charge of their heart health; 7 and 8 9 WHEREAS, each woman should learn her own personal risk for heart 10 disease, using tools such as the American Heart Association's Go Red For 11 Women Heart CheckUp and by talking to her healthcare provider; and 12 13 WHEREAS, making the right choices relating to proper nutrition, physical activity, doctor visits, and other lifestyle methods is essential to 14 15 living a heart-healthy life, 16 17 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-SEVENTH GENERAL 18 19 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS: 20 21 That the House of Representatives recognizes the prevalence of heart 22 disease in women, encourages each Arkansas woman to learn her own personal 23 risk for heart disease and to make the right choices in living a heart-24 healthy life, recognizes February 6, 2009, as National Wear Red Day, and 25 urges all citizens to show their support for women and the fight against 26 heart disease by commemorating this day by wearing the color red. 27 28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon adoption of this resolution, an appropriate 29 copy shall be provided to the Arkansas Chapter of the American Heart 30 Association by the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives. 31 32 33 34 35 36
