- 20 (a) The Department of Arkansas State Police shall prescribe an
- 21 appropriate examination use training and testing materials prepared by the
- 22 Motorcycle Safety Foundation and supplemented with specific state laws to be
- 23 taken by for a person who desires to obtain a motorcycle operator's license
- 24 as required by this subchapter.
- 25 (b) The examination <u>for a person who desires to obtain a motorcycle</u>
- 26 <u>operator's license</u> shall include:
- 27 (1) A written examination produced by the Motorcycle Safety
- 28 Foundation and supplemented with specific state laws that is designed to

- SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 27-20-109(a), regarding motorcycle operator instruction in public schools, is amended to read as follows:
- 16 (a) The Department of Education is authorized to prescribe and offer a
 17 course in shall use training and testing materials produced by the Motorcycle
 18 Safety Foundation and supplemented with specific state laws in approved
 19 courses for motorcycle and motor-driven cycle operator instruction to be that

- 22 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 27-16-706 is amended to read as follows: 23 27-16-706. Written test — Contents.
- 24 The driver's license test shall include written questions concerning:
 - (1) The effects of the consumption of alcoholic beverage products and the use of illegal drugs, prescription drugs, and nonprescription drugs on the ability of a person to operate a motor vehicle;
 - (2) The legal and financial consequences resulting from violations of the state's laws prohibiting the operation of a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol or drugs;
 - (3) Accessible parking for a person with a disability; and
- 32 (4) Penalties for the unauthorized use of parking designated for 33 the exclusive use of a person with a disability; and
- 34 (5) The safety issues related to sharing the roadway with 35 motorcycles.
