21	no salary paid in one (1) of the years which is utilized in the computation
22	of the member's final average salary shall exceed one hundred ten percent
23	(110%) of the salary earned in the year preceding that year used in the
24	computation, unless the increase is a direct result of:
25	(a) A promotion;
26	(b) A change in position;
27	(c) An incremental increase provided in the school district salary
28	schedule; or
29	(d) An increase in school revenues. A full service year of salary
30	used in calculating a member's final average salary for retirement benefits
31	shall not exceed the greater of:

8	Arkansas Teacher Retirement System in an amount not to exceed the amount the
9	employee is required to report for federal income tax purposes.

11	cafeteria plans as defined in § 21-5-901, and employee contributions to $\ensuremath{\mathtt{tax-}}$

14	(ii) However, a member may establish salary earned

19	agreement, judgment, or decree may be counted as salary upon payment of all
20	required member and employer contributions, including interest, to the

23	regular contract and a purchased contract or under both a regular contact and
24	a contract won through litigation shall have the greater of two (2) amounts
25	considered as salary for the purposes of determining the final average salary

27	(v) A retirement annuity may be based on service
28	credit covered by the purchased contract.
29	(vi) A contributory employee's contributions and an
30	employer's contributions are required on covered salary including
31	contributions that are paid concurrently with other remuneration for another
32	covered employer or used in calculating member benefits.
33	(D) Money that is in lieu of remuneration and is used by
34	an employer to purchase a qualified tax-sheltered annuity or a life insurance
35	policy for an employee shall be considered as salary for Arkansas Teacher
36	Retirement System purposes.

1	$\frac{(E)}{(C)}$ An employee A member who is receiving remuneration
2	under both a regular contract and a purchased contract or under both a
3	regular contract and a contract won through litigation, consent agreement,
4	judgment, or decree shall have only the greater of the two (2) amounts
5	considered as salary for Arkansas Teacher Retirement System purposes.
6	(D) A member's contributions if contributory, and an
7	employer's contributions are required on covered salary, including salary
8	that is paid concurrently with other remuneration from another covered
9	employer, even if the salary is not used in calculating member benefits.
10	(E) Retirement annuities may be based on service credit
11	covered by the purchased contract.
12	(F) Should an employee make a charitable donation or
13	return any part of his or her salary to his or her employer, the amount of
14	his or her recurring remuneration otherwise usable as salary shall be reduced
15	by such an amount or amounts to arrive at his or her salary for Arkansas
16	Teacher Retirement System purposes.
17	$\frac{(G)}{(F)}$ In case of any dispute concerning an employee's
18	salary for Arkansas Teacher Retirement System purposes, the Arkansas Teacher

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21	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
22	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that certain provisions of the
23	Arkansas Teacher Retirement System Act are badly in need of revision and
24	updating to bring them into conformance with sound public pension policy;
25	that such revision and updating is of great importance to members of the
26	Arkansas Teacher Retirement System and to other citizens of the State of
27	Arkansas; and that this act is immediately necessary in order to maintain an
28	orderly system of benefits for the members of the Arkansas Teacher Retirement
29	System. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being
30	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall
31	become effective on July 1, 2009.
