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29	SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIAT	ION - PLANT BOARD - FARMERS	MARKETS. There is

33	(A) Effective July 1,	2009, the balance of the ap	propriation provided in

35	expenses for Farmers Marke	ets, in a sum not to exceed	\$355,429.
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1	SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - AQUACULTURE FISHERIES CENTER UPGRADES AND	
2	EXPENSES. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Agriculture	
3	Department, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor	
4	fund or fund accounts, for the Arkansas Agriculture Department, the	
5	following:	
6	(A) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in	
7	Item (A) of Section 61 of Act 1242 of 2007, for equipment upgrades and	
8	operating expenses of the Aquaculture Fisheries Center Laboratory at Lake	
9	Village, in a sum not to exceed\$100,250.	
10	(B) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in	
11	Item (B) of Section 61 of Act 1242 of 2007, for construction, renovation and	
12	equipment for the Aquaculture Fisheries Center to improve facilities and	
13	enhance fish health services for Arkansas Aquaculture through disease	
14	diagnosis, treatment advice and inspection services, in a sum not to exceed	
15	\$137,250.	
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17	SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION - MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION. There is hereby	
18	appropriated, to the Arkansas Agriculture Department, to be payable from the	
19	General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the	
20	Arkansas Agriculture Department, the following:	
21	(A) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in	
22	Item (A) of Section 62 of Act 1242 of 2007, for maintenance and operating	
23	expenses of the Arkansas Agriculture Department, in a sum not to exceed	
24	\$300,000.	
25	(B) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in	
26	Item (D) of Section 57 of Act 1242 of 2007, for expenses of the Arkansas	
27	Agriculture Department, in a sum not to exceed\$26,429.	
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29	SECTION 5. REAPPROPRIATION - GRANTS. There is hereby appropriated, to the	
30	Arkansas Agriculture Department, to be payable from the General Improvement	
31	Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Arkansas Agriculture	
32	Department, the following:	
33	(A) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in	
34	Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 1476 of 2007, for grants for operating and	
35	program expenses for annual festivals, in a sum not to exceed\$45,000.	
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T	SECTION 6. REAPPROPRIATION - LIVESTOCK AND POULTRY - COUNTY FAIR
2	ENHANCEMENT GRANTS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Agriculture
3	Department, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor
4	fund or fund accounts, for the Arkansas Agriculture Department, the
5	following:
6	(A) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in
7	Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1567 of 2007, for enhancement grants for county
8	fairs, in a sum not to exceed\$25,000.
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10	SECTION 7. REAPPROPRIATION - LIVESTOCK AND POULTRY - STATEWIDE GRANTS AND
11	ASSISTANCE. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Agriculture
12	Department, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor
13	fund or fund accounts, for the Arkansas Agriculture Department, the
14	following:
15	(A) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in
16	Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1730 of 2007, for statewide County Fair grants
17	and assistance, in a sum not to exceed\$10,000.
18	(B) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in
19	Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 1730 of 2007, for statewide State Fair grants
20	and assistance, in a sum not to exceed\$100,000.
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22	SECTION 8. REAPPROPRIATION - FORESTRY COMMISSION. There is hereby
23	appropriated, to the Arkansas Agriculture Department, to be payable from the
24	General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the
25	Arkansas Agriculture Department, the following:
26	(A) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in
27	Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 759 of 2007, for Professional Fees for air
28	tankers to fight forest fires during the summer season, in a sum not to
29	exceed\$748,649.
30	(B) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in
31	Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 759 of 2007, for Fire Fighting Equipment to
32	purchase 14 tractor-plow units for fighting forest fires, in a sum not to
33	exceed\$1,541,841.
34	(C) Effective July 1, 2009, the balance of the appropriation provided in
35	Item (C) of Section 1 of Act 759 of 2007, for repair of the Little Rock
36	Administration Office Building North Face, in a sum not to exceed

1	\$220,000.	
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3	SECTION 9. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor	
4	obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects	
5	described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available	
6	therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and	
7	agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and	
8	donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or	
9	funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State	
10	Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects	
11	enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds	
12	otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General	
13	Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall	
14	not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.	
15	(B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing	
16	Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue	
17	Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State	
18	and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,	
19	as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any	
20	funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.	
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22	SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly	
23	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained	
24	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act	
25	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations	
26	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by	
27	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral	
28	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or	
29	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.	
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31	SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General	
32	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the	
33	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the	
34	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of	
35	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in	
36	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective	

1	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
2	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
3	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
4	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
5	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
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
