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15 AN ACT FOR THE SOUTH ARKANSAS COMMUNITY
16 COLLEGE APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2009-2010
17 FISCAL YEAR.
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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for
24 the South Arkansas Community College for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the
25 following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be
26 governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act
27 (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory
28 thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum
29 annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the
30 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons
31 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions
32 of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-
33 101), or its successor.

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the South Arkansas Community College for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: one hundred seventy five (175) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the South Arkansas Community College, to be payable from the South Arkansas Community College Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the South Arkansas Community College for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the following:

SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated, to the South Arkansas Community College, to be payable from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the South Arkansas Community College,

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22 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 23 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
 24 PRIORITIES. A high priority of South Arkansas Community College shall be to
 25 combat illiteracy and to provide industrial training in the work place.

26 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
 27 ~~2007~~ 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

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29 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 30 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND
 31 BALANCES. The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged
 32 with the management or control of the institution of higher learning and the
 33 President or Chancellor as the Chief Executive shall certify to the Chief
 34 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December
 35 31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or
 36 will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during

1 the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due.
2 This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the
3 President or Chancellor, will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or
4 upon release of the previous year's audit by Legislative Audit to the Chief
5 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council accompanied by the
6 Board approved published annual financial statement for the preceding fiscal
7 year.

8 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
9 ~~2007~~ 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

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11 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
12 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
13 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
14 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
15 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
16 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures
17 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
18 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
19 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
20 with in disbursement of said funds.

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22 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
23 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
24 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
25 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
26 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
27 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
28 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
29 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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31 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
32 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
33 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
34 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
35 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
36 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective

1 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
2 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
3 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
4 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
5 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.

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
