AN ACT TO AMEND ACT 1366 OF 2003, CONCERNING HOMELAND SECURITY AND THREAT ASSESSMENT PLANS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Uncodified Section 4 of Act 1366 of 2003, as amended by Act 1823 of 2005 and Act 432 of 2007, concerning homeland security and threat assessment plans, is amended to read as follows:

Section 4. Sunset Clause.
This act expires on July 1, 2009 2011.

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that Act 1366 of 2003, as amended, known as the Homeland Security Information Act, is necessary for the safety and protection of the citizens of the State of Arkansas; that without legislative action the Homeland Security Information Act will expire on July 1, 2009; and that this act is immediately necessary to prevent the expiration of the act. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:
