9 AN ACT TO AMEND ACT 62 OF 2009, THE APPROPRIATION
10 ACT FOR THE PERSONAL SERVICES AND OPERATING
11 EXPENSES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION -
12 EDUCATIONAL TELEVISION DIVISION FOR THE FISCAL
13 YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2010; AND FOR OTHER
14 PURPOSES.

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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26 SECTION 1. Section 1 of Act 62 of 2009 is hereby amended to read as
27 follows:

28 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
29 Department of Education - Educational Television Division for the 2009-2010
30 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries
31 shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and
32 Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and
33 all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a
34 specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt
35 from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All
36 persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the



1 provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas
 2 Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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24 SECTION 2. Section 3 of Act 62 of 2009 is hereby amended to read as
 25 follows:

26 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,
 27 to the Department of Education - Educational Television Division, to be
 28 payable from the Educational Television Fund Account, for personal services
 29 and operating expenses of the Department of Education - Educational
 30 Television Division - State Operations for the fiscal year ending June 30,
 31 2010, the following:

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12 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
 13 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
 14 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
 15 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 16 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 17 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 18 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 19 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 20 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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22 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
 23 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
 24 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
 25 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
 26 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
 27 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
 28 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
 29 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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31 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
 32 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
 33 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
 34 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
 35 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
 36 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective

1 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
2 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
3 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
4 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
5 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.

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
