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26	SECTION 1. Arkansas (Code Title 19, Chapter 5, is amend	ded to add an
27	additional section to read as follows:		
28	19-5-1236. Technology Acceleration Fund.		
29	(a) There is created on the books of the Treasurer of State, the Auditor of		
30	State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a miscellaneous fund to be		
31	known as the "Technology	y Acceleration Fund".	
32	(b)(1) The fund shall consist of funds transferred to it from the General		
33	Improvement Fund or other funds, gifts, bequests, foundation grants and		
34	gifts, Governor's or other emergency funds, federal grants and matching		
35	funds, proceeds from bor	nd issues, service charges or fees	s, interagency
36	transfers of funds and	other funds as may be appropriate	ad by the Ceneral

- 2 (2) The Technology Acceleration Fund shall consist of money transferred
- 3 <u>from the General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund and any other money provided</u>
- 4 by law.
- 5 (c) The Technology Acceleration Fund shall be used by the Arkansas Economic
- 6 Development Commission, the Arkansas Science and Technology Authority, and
- 7 the Arkansas Development Finance Authority for investment incentives to
- 8 enhance the economy of the state through technology development.
- 9 (d) Money from the Technology Acceleration Fund may be used in conjunction
- 10 with other incentives offered by the state to create, attract, or retain
- ll business.
- 12 (e)(1) Any proposed use of the Technology Acceleration Fund by the Arkansas
- 13 Economic Development Commission, Arkansas Science and Technology Authority,
- 14 or Arkansas Development Finance Authority shall first be approved by the
- 15 Governor.
- 16 (2) The Arkansas Economic Development Commission, the Arkansas Science and
- 17 Technology Authority, and the Arkansas Development Finance Authority shall
- 18 make a joint recommendation to the Governor for any proposed use of the
- 19 Technology Acceleration Fund.

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- 21 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION TECHNOLOGY DEVELOPMENT. There is hereby
- 22 appropriated, to the Economic Development Commission, to be payable from the
- 23 Technology Acceleration Fund, the following:
- 24 (A) For investment incentives to enhance the economy of the State through
- 25 technology development, the sum of\$0.

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- 27 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
- 28 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
- 29 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
- 30 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
- 31 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 32 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
- 33 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
- 34 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
- 35 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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1	SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly		
2	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained		
3	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act		
4	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations		
5	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by		
6	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral		
7	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or		
8	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.		
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10	SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General		
11	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the		
12	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the		
13	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of		
14	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in		
15	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective		
16	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the		
17	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.		
18	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being		
19	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and		
20	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.		
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
