6	items sold as part of a bundled package;			
7	(2) That some components of a bundled package may not be			
8	reusable by another student;			
9	(3) The quoted on-campus retail price for each textbook or			
10	course material he or she selects; and			
11	(4) That the publisher of a textbook or course material has			
12	acknowledged that all components of a bundled package may be purchased and			
13	sold separately by a local textbook retailer.			
14	(c) As used in this section, "bundled package" means any combination			
15	of one (1) or more reusable textbooks and one (1) or more nonreusable			
16	textbooks, workbooks, CD-ROMs, floppy disks, passwords, interactive hand-held			
17	remote devices, flash drives, or any other memory-storing device packaged as			
18	a single item for sale.
