31	Martin Luther King, Jr., and in observation of his birthday, neither the
32	House of Representatives nor the Senate shall convene in session nor shall
33	any of their committees meet on the third Monday in January; and

35	WHEREAS, Monday, January 19, 2009, is the third Monday in January of

2	WHEREAS, on January 20, 2009, President-elect Barack Obama will be
3	sworn in as the forty-fourth President of the United States and both houses
4	of the Arkansas General Assembly wish to recess on that date in recognition
5	of that historic event; and

7	WHEREAS, Article 5, Section 28 of the Arkansas Constitution provides
8	that neither house of the General Assembly may adjourn for more than three
9	(3) days without the consent of the other house; and

11	WHEREAS, the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Eighty-
12	seventh General Assembly wish to resume their work on Wednesday, January 21,
13	2009,

15	NOW THEREFORE,
16	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE

19	THAT the Senate will recess at the close of business Thursday, January
20	15, 2009; that the House of Representatives will recess at the close of
21	business Friday, January 16, 2009; and that both houses will reconvene at
22	1:00 p.m. Wednesday, January 21, 2009.
