29	WHEREAS, United States Highway 71, which is commonly referred to as
30	Interstate 49 (I-49), is the north-south corridor from Kansas City, Missouri,
31	to Shreveport, Louisiana; and
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33	WHEREAS, the United States Congress designated I-49 as a High Priority
34	Corridor l under the Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act of 1991
35	(ISTEA); and

1	WHEREAS, the I-49 corridor from Texarkana to Fort Smith will provide a
2	much-needed north-to-south route on the west side of the state that will
3	provide the necessary infrastructure to support economic development
4	immediately and for future generations;
5	
6	WHEREAS, the moneys spent on the I-49 corridor include numerous
7	environmental studies and location studies that have been completed in
8	segments due to the length and nature of the project; and
9	
10	WHEREAS, to date, approximately nine hundred seventy million dollars
11	(\$970,000,000) in federal and state moneys have been spent on major
12	improvements to the I-49 corridor; and
13	
14	WHEREAS, the present cost of completing I-49 is estimated to be three
15	billion five hundred million dollars (\$3,500,000,000); and

17	WHEREAS, the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation
18	Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU) expires on September 30, 2009,
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20	NOW THEREFORE,
21	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
22	STATE OF ARKANSAS, AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:
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24	That it recommends to the Congress of the United States, the Arkansas
25	Congressional Delegation, the President of the United States, the Secretary
26	of the Department of Transportation, and the Director of the Federal Highway
27	Administration that a significant portion of funding for transportation
28	infrastructure be committed to complete construction of I-49 between
29	Texarkana, Arkansas, and Ft. Smith, Arkansas.
