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- 31 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 32 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. AGING AND
- 33 ADULT SERVICES MATCHING FUNDS. The funds appropriated for state match for
- 34 the Arkansas Senior Olympics Program in this Act shall be paid on a two-to-
- 35 one state/local matching basis. The Senior Arkansas Sports Organization must
- 36 certify its portion of the match to the Division of Aging and Adult Services

- 1 before any funds appropriated for state match for the Arkansas Senior

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- 6 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. AGING AND
- 8 ADULT SERVICES STATE MATCH AUTHORIZED. The Director of the Department of
- 9 Human Services is authorized to use State funds appropriated in this Act to
- 10 match Federal funds available under Title III and Title V of the Older
- 11 Americans Act, Social Services Block Grant, or such other federal funds as
- 12 may become available.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007

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- 16 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 17 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. AGING AND
- 18 ADULT SERVICES GRANT/CONTRACT DISBURSEMENT GUIDELINES. All appropriations
- 19 for state and federal funding contained herein for the Division of Aging and
- 20 Adult Services and that are distributed under grant or contract methodologies
- 21 may be disbursed by the Department of Human Services in the same manner as
- 22 authorized under federal regulations for the disbursement of Title III Older
- 23 Americans Act funds. Otherwise, all disbursements shall comply with the
- 24 provisions of this Act.
- 25 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007

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- 28 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 29 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. AGING AND
- 30 ADULT SERVICES NURSING HOME CARE ALTERNATIVES. Funding for "Nursing Home
- 31 Care Alternatives", as it appears in the Aging and Adult Services -
- 32 Operations appropriation may be used for home delivered meals, adult day
- 33 care, homemaker/chore, respite care, personal care, health promotion, and
- 34 other community-based activities. These funds may also be used to match
- 35 Medicaid community-based programs.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007

1 2010 through June 30, 2009 2011. 2 3 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 4 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 5 CITIZEN CENTERS. The appropriation in this act for Senior Citizen Centers 6 shall be distributed in the same manner as the funding formula requirements 7 set out in the federal Older Americans Act funding law. The additional 8 funding provided by this provision shall supplement and not supplant any 9 monies currently funding services for Senior Citizen Centers. 10 The requirements in this section shall only be implemented in accordance 11 with any necessary approval by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services 12 and in the event that additional general revenue funding is provided by the 13 General Assembly for these purposes. Should additional funding provided for 14 these purposes be insufficient to provide for the increases in full, the 15 increases shall be provided to the extent that funding is made available. 16 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007 17 2010 through June 30, 2009 2011. 18 SECTION 13. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 19 20 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 21 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 22 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 23 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 24 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 25 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 26 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 27 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 28 SECTION 14. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 29 30 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 31 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 32 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 33 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 34 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 35 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or

Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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2	SECTION 15. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
3	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
4	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
5	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2010 is essential to the operation of
6	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
7	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
8	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2010 could work irreparable harm
9	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
10	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
11	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
12	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2010.
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
