SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE ARKANSAS
AGRICULTURE DEPARTMENT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING
JUNE 30, 2011; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS AGRICULTURE
DEPARTMENT APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2010-
2011 FISCAL YEAR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for the Arkansas Agriculture Department for the 2010-2011 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

28 PROVISION - PEST ERADICATION. If the State Plant Board determines that the
29 demands of pest eradication efforts require additional personnel expenses,
30 with the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and approval by
31 the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, appropriations may be
32 transferred from the Pest Eradication Program special line item to the line
33 items for Regular Salaries, Extra Help, Overtime, and Personal Services
34 Matching.

35 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
36 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year

1 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
 2 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
 3 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
 4 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
 5 has determined that the State Plant Board may operate more efficiently if
 6 some flexibility is provided to the State Plant Board authorizing broad
 7 powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate
 8 that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of
 9 the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by this
 10 section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint
 11 Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement
 12 of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled
 13 unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is
 14 void.

15 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2007~~
 16 2010 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2011.

17
 18 SECTION 48. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 19 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA
 20 HELP PROVISION. No employee of the Arkansas Forestry Commission who is
 21 employed as "Extra Help" may receive an amount to exceed 3/4 of the maximum
 22 annual salary for a comparable position as authorized by Arkansas Code 21-5-
 23 201 et seq. during any fiscal year, nor may such employee be employed for a
 24 period of time to exceed nine (9) months in any single fiscal year.
 25 Provided, however, that no employee of the Arkansas Forestry Commission who
 26 is employed as "Extra Help" may receive an amount to exceed seventy five
 27 percent (75%) of the maximum annual salary for a comparable position as
 28 authorized by Arkansas Code 21-5-201 et seq. during any fiscal year, nor
 29 shall such employee be employed for a period of time to exceed fourteen
 30 hundred (1400) hours in any single fiscal year.

31 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2007~~
 32 2010 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2011.

33
 34 SECTION 49. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 35 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
 36 PROVISION. If the State Forestry Commission determines that temporary

1 firefighters, dispatchers, or pilots are required to meet the demands of a
2 wildfire season, and upon approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State,
3 appropriations may be transferred from either Extra Help or Professional Fees
4 and Services to the proper character code for the employment of such
5 personnel.

6 If the State Forestry Commission determines that the deployment of air
7 tankers for fighting wildfires requires additional Professional Fees and
8 Services, and upon the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State,
9 excess appropriation in Regular Salaries or Personal Services Matching may be
10 transferred to Professional Fees and Services in Section 3 and 31.

11 If the State Forestry Commission determines that the most effective way for
12 it to cooperate in the growing and distribution of forest planting stock is
13 by contracting work with private vendors and/or hiring temporary employees
14 for seasonal work, the Commission is hereby authorized, upon approval by the
15 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, to transfer the necessary appropriation
16 authorized for Extra Help and Maintenance and General Operation in Section 3
17 and 31.

18 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2007~~
19 2010 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2011.

20
21 SECTION 50. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
22 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REFUND TO
23 EXPENDITURE. The Arkansas Forestry Commission is authorized to charge fees
24 to federal agencies and other states to reimburse the Commission for
25 expenditures made on behalf of these governmental units. These fees shall be
26 deposited into the State Forestry Fund in the State Treasury as a refund to
27 expenditure.

28 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
29 ~~2007~~ 2010 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2011.

30
31 SECTION 51. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
32 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
33 ALLOCATION RESTRICTIONS. The Secretary of the Arkansas Department of
34 Agriculture shall at no time designate general revenue allocations to the
35 State Plant Board, the Arkansas Livestock and Poultry Commission and the
36 Arkansas Forestry Commission at a level less than the revenue distribution

1 provided in the Official Forecast of state general revenue in effect for each
2 of those agencies.

3 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
4 2010 through June 30, 2011.

5
6 SECTION 52. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
7 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
8 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
9 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
10 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
11 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
12 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
13 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
14 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

15
16 SECTION 53. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
17 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
18 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
19 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
20 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
21 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
22 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
23 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

24
25 SECTION 54. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
26 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
27 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
28 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2010 is essential to the operation of
29 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
30 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
31 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2010 could work irreparable harm
32 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
33 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
34 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
35 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2010.
