AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE LAW RELATED TO SPEED LIMITS NEAR SCHOOLS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO CLARIFY THE LAW RELATED TO SPEED
LIMITS NEAR SCHOOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-51-212 is amended to read as follows:
27-51-212. Speed limit near schools - Exceptions.
(a) (1) As used in this section, "when children are present" means when one (l) or more children occupy:
(A) A crosswalk that is part of a school zone;
(B) A road or highway that is part of a school zone; or
(C) A sidewalk or shoulder of a road or highway that provides unimpeded access to a road or highway that borders a school zone.
(2) "When children are present" also includes when a traffic control person in his or her official gear or clothing is present at a crosswalk to assist children as they arrive at or leave school, even if a child is not present at the time;
(a)(b) No A person shall not operate a motor vehicle in excess of twenty-five (25) miles per hour ( $25 \mathrm{~m} . \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{h}$. ) when passing a school building of school zone during school hours when children are present and outside the building.
(b)(c) This The speed limit under this section shall not be applicable upon does not apply to the freeways and interstate highways of this state or
to school zones adequately protected by a steel fence limiting access to and egress entry to and exit from safety crossings.
