8 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL  
9 SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE COSSATOT  
10 COMMUNITY COLLEGE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS  
11 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2012; AND FOR  
12 OTHER PURPOSES.

16 AN ACT FOR THE COSSATOT COMMUNITY COLLEGE  
17 OF THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS APPROPRIATION  
18 FOR THE 2011-2012 FISCAL YEAR.  
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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established  
24 for the Cossatot Community College of the University of Arkansas for the  
25 2011-2012 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular employees.

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16 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for  
 17 the Cossatot Community College of the University of Arkansas for the 2011-  
 18 2012 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary  
 19 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated  
 20 herein for such purposes: one hundred (100) temporary or part-time  
 21 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the  
 22 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act  
 23 for the appropriate classification.

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25 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby  
 26 appropriated, to the Cossatot Community College of the University of  
 27 Arkansas, to be payable from the Cossatot Community College of the University  
 28 of Arkansas Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the  
 29 Cossatot Community College of the University of Arkansas for the fiscal year  
 30 ending June 30, 2012, the following:

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9 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated,  
 10 to the Cossatot Community College of the University of Arkansas, to be  
 11 payable from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Cossatot  
 12 Community College of the University of Arkansas, for personal services and  
 13 operating expenses of the Cossatot Community College of the University of  
 14 Arkansas for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012, the following:

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32 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 33 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.  
 34 PRIORITIES. ~~High priorities of the Cossatot Community College of the~~  
 35 ~~University of Arkansas shall be the development and implementation of~~  
 36 ~~technical programs designed to: Cossatot Community College of the University~~

1 of Arkansas considers the following items HIGH PRIORITY and within the role  
2 and scope of the college:

3 ~~(1) upgrade skills of current employees in service area businesses and~~  
4 ~~industries, The recruitment of underserved populations in the CCCUA service~~  
5 ~~area, including but not limited to: Latinos, African Americans, Aging, and~~  
6 ~~Non-Traditional students,~~

7 ~~(2) to combat illiteracy and English language deficiencies, The development~~  
8 ~~and offering of viable programs as defined by the Arkansas Department of~~  
9 ~~Higher Education and the deletion of programs which are not viable,~~

10 ~~(3) to increase the number of skilled workers available for employments, The~~  
11 ~~cultivating of relationships in the community that establishes more industry~~  
12 ~~training and promotes economic development within the CCCUA service area,~~

13 ~~(4) to provide leadership for school-to-work programs including cooperation~~  
14 ~~with area public schools, businesses, industries, and labor groups, and The~~  
15 ~~continued development of working relationships with area K-12 institutions to~~  
16 ~~provide concurrent enrollment, Advanced Placement, technical training, and~~  
17 ~~college readiness to these students,~~

18 ~~(5) to provide the first two years of baccalaureate education transferable to~~  
19 ~~colleges and universities in the general community area of the College and~~  
20 ~~the State of Arkansas. The development of a comprehensive change in the way~~  
21 ~~the college prepares students for college-level work, including the~~  
22 ~~development of special mastery learning programs within remedial math and~~  
23 ~~English courses,~~

24 ~~(6) The continued expansion of campus facilities to accommodate continued~~  
25 ~~record growth in credit and non-credit programs.~~

26 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  
27 ~~2010~~ 2011 through June 30, ~~2011~~ 2012.

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29 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
30 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
31 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
32 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
33 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
34 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures  
35 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this  
36 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of

1 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied  
2 with in disbursement of said funds.

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4 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
5 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
6 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
7 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
8 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
9 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
10 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
11 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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13 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
14 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
15 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
16 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2011 is essential to the operation of  
17 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
18 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
19 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2011 could work irreparable harm  
20 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
21 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
22 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
23 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2011.
