  - (2) Any currently certified Arkansas emergency medical services personnel who has before March 17, 1999, submitted criminal background information specific to offenses listed by the applicant on the Arkansas emergency medical services personnel certification application to the division and has been allowed to become certified based upon the information provided by the applicant, that certification shall not be suspended during the request for waiver.

- (a) After receipt of a request for a criminal history check, the Identification Bureau of the Department of Arkansas State Police shall make reasonable efforts to respond to requests for state or national criminal history checks, or both, within twenty (20) calendar days.
- (b) The Division of EMS and Trauma Systems of the Division of Health of the Department of Health and Human Services Department of Health shall maintain on file for a period of three (3) years, subject to inspection by the Arkansas Crime Information Center or the bureau Identification Bureau of the Department of Arkansas State Police, a copy of each criminal records history check completed by all applicants requesting state certification.
