AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE ROLE OF PHARMACISTS WITH REGARD
TO EPHEDRINE, PSEUDOEPHEDRINE, OR
PHENYLPROPANOLAMINE; TO IMPROVE THE PROCESS FOR
IDENTIFYING PERSONS AUTHORIZED TO PURCHASE EPHEDRINE,
PSEUDOEPHEDRINE, OR PHENYLPROPANOLAMINE; TO AUTHORIZE
THE ARKANSAS STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY TO PROPOSE
ADDITIONS TO THE LIST OF DRUGS SIMILAR TO EPHEDRINE,
PSEUDOEPHEDRINE, OR PHENYLPROPANOLAMINE; AND FOR
OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to clarify the role of
pharmacists with regard to ephedrine, pseudoephedrine, or
phenylpropanolamine.
