19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 11-10-514(a)(3), concerning the
22 continuation of a disqualification for misconduct, is amended to read as
23 follows:

24 (3)(A) Except as otherwise provided in this section, an
25 individual's disqualification for misconduct shall be for eight (8) weeks of
26 unemployment as defined in § 11-10-512.

27 (B) However, for a discharge that occurs during the period
28 of July 1, 2009, through ~~June 30, 2011~~ June 30, 2015, the disqualification
29 under subdivision (a)(3)(A) of this section shall continue until, subsequent
30 to filing a claim, he or she has had at least thirty (30) days of employment
31 covered by an unemployment compensation law of this state, another state, or
32 the United States.
