an act to increase the supplemental payments for RETIRED POLICE OFFICERS OR THEIR SURVIVORS UNDER THE LOCAL POLICE AND FIRE PENSION AND RELIEF FUNDS; TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle<br>TO INCREASE THE SUPPLEMENTAL PAYMENTS FOR RETIRED POLICE OFFICERS OR THEIR SURVIVORS UNDER THE LOCAL POLICE AND FIRE PENSION AND RELIEF FUNDS AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-11-211(d)(2), concerning the Arkansas Policemen's Pension Supplement Program, is amended to read as follows:
(2) A retired police officer or a survivor currently receiving retirement benefits from a local policemen's pension and relief fund of four hundred dollars (\$400) or more per month shall receive a supplement under the program of fifty dollars (\$50.00) one hundred dollars (\$100) per month.

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that police officers put their lives on the line to protect the citizens of their communities; that the cost of living has increased; that the fiscal year for retirement systems begins July 1, 2011; and that police officers are in dire need of additional retirement benefits. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and
safety shall become effective on July 1, 2011.
